Teachers with a common base of literacy professional development can be more effective in helping all students reach grade appropriate achievement in literacy.

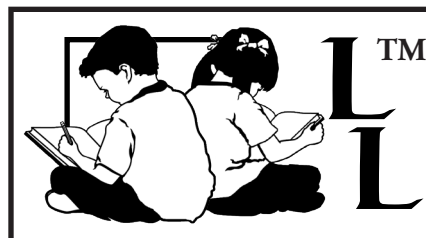
Literacy Intervention Teams are recommended to work cooperatively across grade levels.

The professional development plan includes:

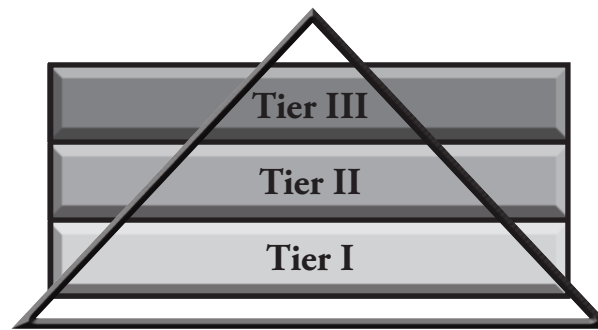
- Four linked graduate level courses across two academic years taken locally at teacher training sites.
