Reading Recovery Implementation Grant for Ohio

The Reading Recovery Implementation Grant for Ohio provides one or more financial grant(s) in the amount up to \$50,000 to support the training of a new teacher leader for Ohio. The award will be used to defray costs associated with teacher leader training.

Presently, 13 regional Reading Recovery teacher training sites operate in Ohio. Each site is directed by a Reading Recovery teacher leader who trains and provides professional development to Reading Recovery teachers. Teacher leader training includes the successful completion of 21 post-master's graduate coursework at OSU over three quarters. Teacher leaders in training teach Reading Recovery students at their home district while completing the teacher leader coursework.

Teacher Leader Requirements

The successful applicant must

- Be sponsored for training by an existing regional teacher training site, or by a newly formed site;
- Be accepted by OSU for the post-master's coursework; and,
- Have a master's degree in a related field.

- If a new site, submit a completed application to establish a new regional Reading Recovery Teacher Training site. Applications are available at www.rrosu.org.
- A proposal (maximum two pages) describing the need to train a Reading Recovery teacher leader for the site.
